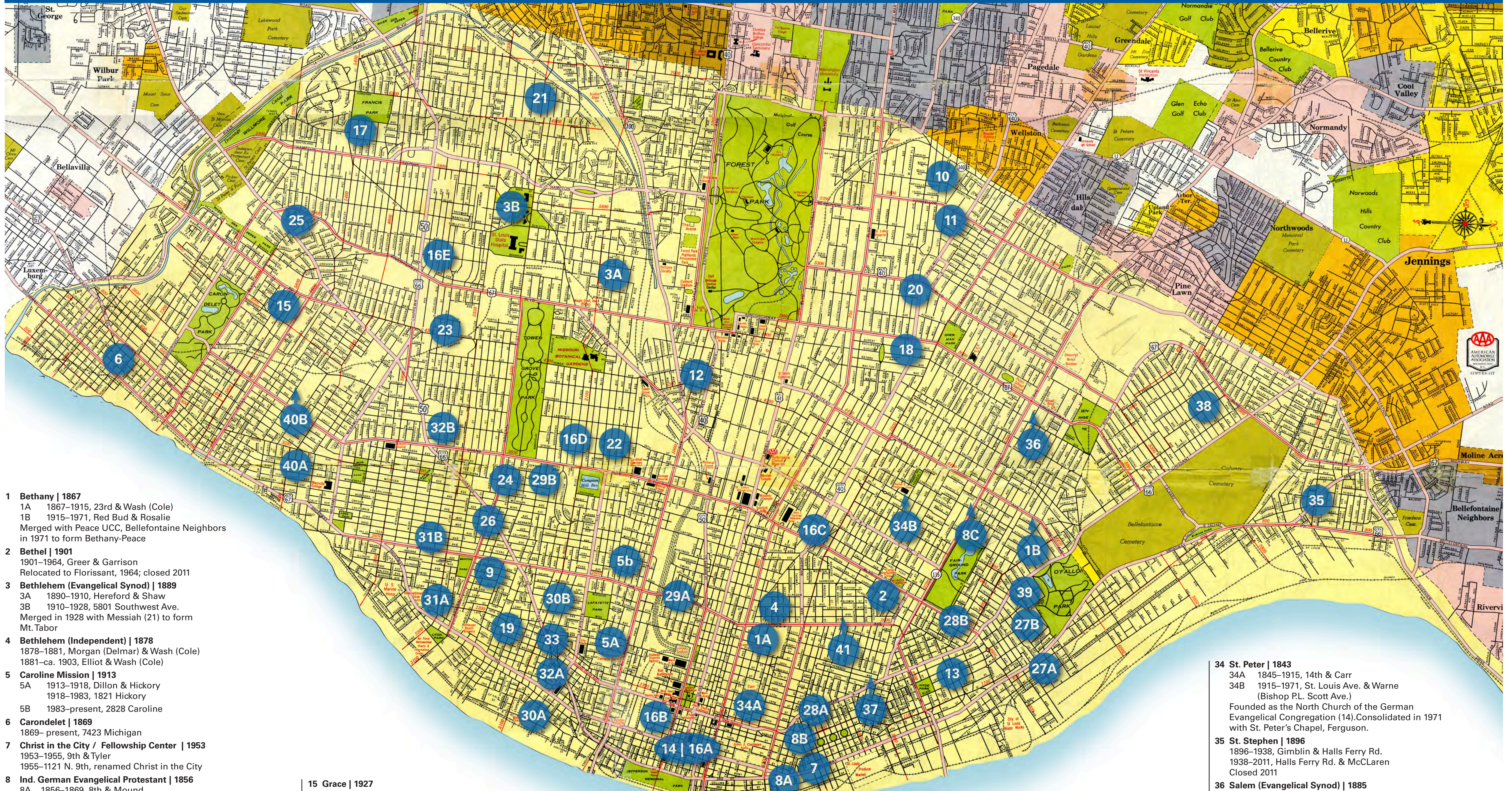


# CONGREGATIONS IN ST. LOUIS CITY ORIGINATING IN THE GERMAN EVANGELICAL SYNOD OF NORTH AMERICA AND RELATED TRADITIONS




- 1 Bethany | 1867**  
1A 1867–1915, 23rd & Wash (Cole)  
1B 1915–1971, Red Bud & Rosalie  
Merged with Peace UCC, Bellefontaine Neighbors in 1971 to form Bethany-Peace
- 2 Bethel | 1901**  
1901–1964, Greer & Garrison  
Relocated to Florissant, 1964; closed 2011
- 3 Bethlehem (Evangelical Synod) | 1889**  
3A 1890–1910, Hereford & Shaw  
3B 1910–1928, 5801 Southwest Ave.  
Merged in 1928 with Messiah (21) to form Mt. Tabor
- 4 Bethlehem (Independent) | 1878**  
1878–1881, Morgan (Delmar) & Wash (Cole)  
1881–ca. 1903, Elliot & Wash (Cole)
- 5 Caroline Mission | 1913**  
5A 1913–1918, Dillon & Hickory  
1918–1983, 1821 Hickory  
5B 1983–present, 2828 Caroline
- 6 Carondelet | 1869**  
1869–present, 7423 Michigan
- 7 Christ in the City / Fellowship Center | 1953**  
1953–1955, 9th & Tyler  
1955–1121 N. 9th, renamed Christ in the City
- 8 Ind. German Evangelical Protestant | 1856**  
8A 1856–1869, 8th & Mound  
8B 1869–1917, 13th & Webster (Tyler)  
8C 1917–1960, Fair & Margaretta  
Relocated to Florissant, 1960; known as Christ the King UCC since 1998. Founded by a group that left Holy Ghost (16).
- 9 Ebenezer | 1886**  
1886–1964, 2911 McNair  
Merged with St. Andrew in 1964 to become Epiphany UCC (below)
- 10 Eden | 1892**  
1892–1895, met in home on Olive  
1895–1919, Hamilton & Bartmer  
Merged in 1919 with Immanuel (18) to form Eden-Immanuel (11)
- 11 Eden-Immanuel | 1919**  
1921–1971, 5630 Page  
Closed, 1971. Founded as a merger of Eden (10) and Immanuel (17)
- 12 Emmaus | 1896**  
1896–1976, 4347 Chouteau (at Tower Grove Ave.)  
Closed, 1976
- 9 Epiphany | 1964**  
1964–present, 2911 Mc Nair
- 13 Friedens | 1857**  
1857–1861, 9th & Penrose  
1861–2008, 19th & Newhouse  
Closed, 2008
- 14 German Evangelical Congregation | 1843**  
1843–1845, Benton School, 6th & Locust  
Founded by a group that left Holy Ghost. See: St. Peter (34), St. Marcus (30).

- 15 Grace | 1927**  
1928–present, 5700 Leona
- 16 Holy Ghost | 1834**  
16A 1834–1840, Benton School, 6th & Locust  
16B 1840–1858, 7th & Clark  
1858–1895, 8th & Walnut  
16C 1895–1923, Grand & Page  
16D 1923–1928, Spring & Flad  
16E 1928–2007, 4916 Mardel
- 17 Hope | 1943**  
1948–present, 6273 Eichelberger
- 18 Immanuel | 1889**  
1889–1919, Euclid & Maple  
Merged in 1919 with Eden (9) to form Eden-Immanuel (11).
- 19 Jesus | 1894**  
1894–1896, Soulard Market Hall, 8th & Lafayette  
1896–2000, 12th & Victor  
Absorbed St. Pauls-Friedens (33) in 1913.
- 20 Maple Avenue Reformed | 1899**  
1899–ca. 1915, Maple & Clarendon  
Last listed in 1915 city directory
- 21 Messiah | 1924**  
1924–1928, 6520 Arsenal  
Merged in 1928 with Bethlehem (3) to form Mt. Tabor (below).

- 22 Mt. Hope | 1935**  
1935–1938, location unknown  
1938–1962, 3661 Detonty  
Formed by a group that left Pilgrim (24).  
Absorbed by St. Luke, 1962.
- 21 Mt. Tabor | 1928**  
1928–present, 6520 Arsenal
- 23 Nazareth | 1903**  
1903–1906, Morganford & Miami  
1906–1994, Morganford & Tholozan  
Closed, 1994
- 24 Pilgrim | 1914**  
1914–1983, 3325 Arsenal  
Closed, 1984. In 1935, a group left this congregation to form Mt. Hope (22).
- 25 Redeemer | 1908**  
1908–1912, various meeting places  
1912–present, 6450 S. Kingshighway
- 26 St. Andrew | 1899**  
1899–1901, various meeting places  
1901–1964, California & Juniata  
Merged in 1964 with Ebenezer (9) to form Epiphany
- 27 St. James | 1869**  
27A 1869–1887, DeSoto & McKissock  
27B 1887–1979, 1505 E. College  
Closed, 1979

- 28 St. John | 1852**  
28A 1852–1853, 12th St. between O'Fallon & Cass  
1854–1923, 14th & Madison  
28B 1923–present, 4136 N. Grand
- 29 St. Luke | 1870**  
29A 1870–1906, Jefferson & Scott  
29B 1906–2011, 2336 Tennessee  
Closed, 2011
- 30 St. Marcus | 1843**  
30A 1845–1915, Jackson (3rd St.) & Soulard (Lafayette)  
30B 1915–present, Russell & McNair  
Founded as the South Church of the German Evangelical Congregation (14).
- 31 St. Matthew | 1875**  
31A 1875–1876, 2622 Carondelet (Broadway)  
1876–1888, 7th St. & Cave  
31B 1888–2014, Jefferson & Potomac  
Closed 2014
- 32 St. Paul | 1848**  
32A 1848–1924, 1808 S. 9th St.  
32B 1924–present, Giles & Potomac  
Founded by a group that left St. Marcus (30).
- 33 St. Pauls-Friedens | 1882**  
1882–1913, 13th & Allen  
Founded by a group that left St. Paul (32).

- 34 St. Peter | 1843**  
34A 1845–1915, 14th & Carr  
34B 1915–1971, St. Louis Ave. & Warne (Bishop PL. Scott Ave.)  
Founded as the North Church of the German Evangelical Congregation (14). Consolidated in 1971 with St. Peter's Chapel, Ferguson.
- 35 St. Stephen | 1896**  
1896–1938, Gimblin & Halls Ferry Rd.  
1938–2011, Halls Ferry Rd. & McClaren  
Closed 2011
- 36 Salem (Evangelical Synod) | 1885**  
1885–1898, Marcus & Margaretta  
1886–1962, Shreve & Margaretta  
1962–present, 2490 Pohlman Ave., Florissant
- 37 Salem (Reformed) | 1888**  
1888–1949, 14th & Sullivan  
Merged in 1949 with Peace E&R, Bellefontaine Neighbors to form Bethany-Peace.
- 38 Salvator | 1906**  
1906–1907, met various places in Walnut Park  
1907–1979, Thekla & Plover  
Closed 1979
- 39 Second English | 1911**  
1911–1915, Alice & Grant  
Absorbed in 1919 by Bethel (2)
- 40 Trinity | 1893**  
40A 1893–1895, Michigan & Neosho  
1894–1931, 3124 Neosho  
40B 1931–2005, 4700 S. Grand  
Relocated in 2005 to 5200 Hilda Ave., Afton
- 41 Zion | 1868**  
1868–1872, 23rd & Montgomery  
1872–1969, 2506 Benton  
1971–present, 5710 N. Highway 140, Florissant

 Indicates a congregation relocated to St. Louis County.
