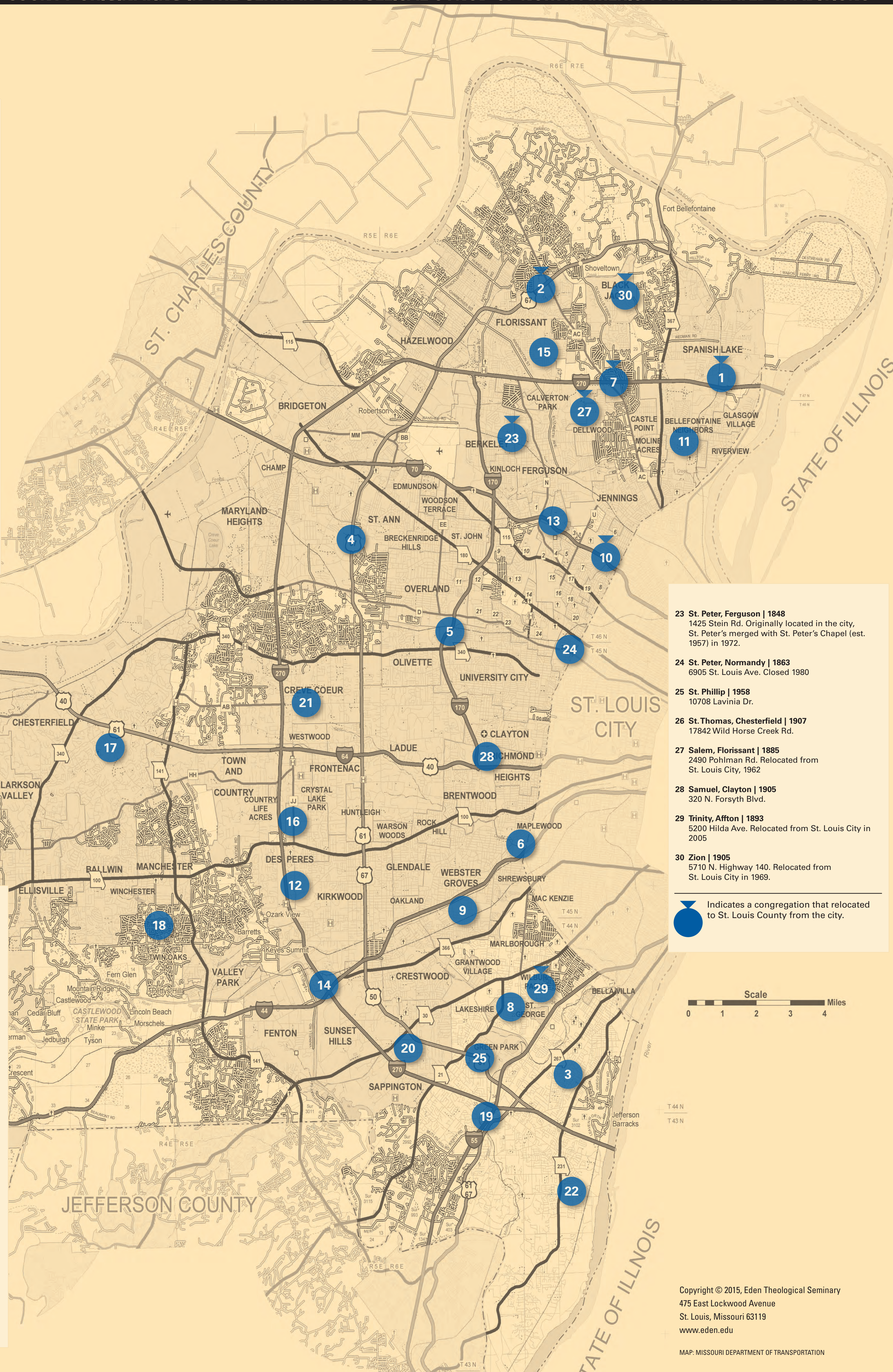


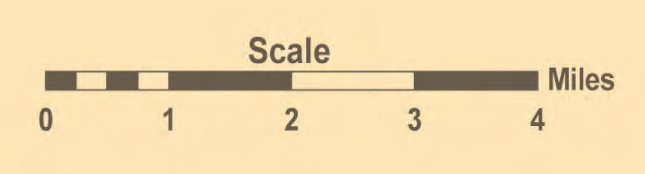
# CONGREGATIONS IN ST. LOUIS COUNTY ORIGINATING IN THE GERMAN EVANGELICAL SYNOD OF NORTH AMERICA AND RELATED TRADITIONS

- 1 **Bethany-Peace, Spanish Lake | 1955**  
11952 Bellefontaine Rd. Founded as Peace. Absorbed Bethany, Red Bud & Rosalie. St. Louis City in 1971. See map of city congregations.
- 2 **Bethel, Florissant | 1901**  
14700 New Halls Ferry Rd. Relocated from St. Louis City in 1964
- 3 **Bethesda, Lemay | 1907**  
1907-1910, met in area homes  
1910-1960, 405 Hoffmeister Ave.  
1960-present, 85 Lemay Gardens Dr.
- 4 **Bethlehem, Bridgeton | 1959**  
11625 Old St. Charles Rock Rd.  
Closed 2009
- 5 **Calvary, Overland | 1929**  
2501 Hartland Ave.
- 6 **Christ, Maplewood | 1889**  
1889-1891, met at Benton Hall  
1891-1919, 7121 Manchester  
1919-present, 7126 Bruno
- 7 **Christ the King, Florissant | 1856**  
1960-present, 11370 Old Halls Ferry Rd. Founded as Independent German Evangelical Protestant. Relocated from Fair & Margaretta. See map of city congregations. Known as Christ the King since 1998.
- 8 **Eden, Affton | 1912**  
8930 Eden Ave.
- 9 **Evangelical (Peace), Webster Groves | 1920**  
204 E. Lockwood. Known as Peace since 2011.
- 10 **Faith-Salem, Jennings | 1943**  
7348 West Florissant Ave. Founded as Faith. Merged in 1949 with Salem Reformed, 14th & Sullivan in St. Louis City (see map of city congregations). Closed 2000.



- 11 **Friedens Chapel, Bellefontaine Neighbors | 1952**  
1060 Chambers Rd. Closed 2012.
- 12 **German Evangelical, Des Peres | 1838**  
1838-1848, Manchester & Ballas. Splits resulted in St. Paul, Creve Coeur (21) and Parkway (16). Remaining congregation is extant as St. Paul's Lutheran.
- 13 **Immanuel, Ferguson | 1888**  
126 Church St.
- 14 **Kirkwood Evangelical & Reformed | 1952**  
1603 Dougherty Ferry Rd.
- 15 **Master, Church of the, Florissant | 1956**  
1325 Paddock Dr.
- 16 **Parkway, Des Peres | 1848**  
2841 Ballas Rd. Organized as German Evangelical Congregation on Ballas Rd. as a split from the German Evangelical Congregation at Manchester & Ballas (12). Later known as Zion. Current name adopted in 1958.
- 17 **St. John, Chesterfield | 1892**  
15370 Olive Blvd.
- 18 **St. John, Manchester | 1860**  
332 Old Sulpher Springs Rd.
- 19 **St. John, Mehlville | 1838**  
11333 St. John's Church Rd.
- 20 **St. Lucas, Sappington | 1880**  
11735 Denny Rd.
- 21 **St. Paul, Creve Coeur | 1843**  
9801 Olive Blvd. Founded by a group from the German Evangelical Congregation, Des Peres (12).
- 22 **St. Paul, Oakville | 1844**  
5508 Telegraph Rd.
- 23 **St. Peter, Ferguson | 1848**  
1425 Stein Rd. Originally located in the city. St. Peter's merged with St. Peter's Chapel (est. 1957) in 1972.
- 24 **St. Peter, Normandy | 1863**  
6905 St. Louis Ave. Closed 1980
- 25 **St. Phillip | 1958**  
10708 Lavinia Dr.
- 26 **St. Thomas, Chesterfield | 1907**  
17842 Wild Horse Creek Rd.
- 27 **Salem, Florissant | 1885**  
2490 Pohlman Rd. Relocated from St. Louis City, 1962
- 28 **Samuel, Clayton | 1905**  
320 N. Forsyth Blvd.
- 29 **Trinity, Affton | 1893**  
5200 Hilda Ave. Relocated from St. Louis City in 2005
- 30 **Zion | 1905**  
5710 N. Highway 140. Relocated from St. Louis City in 1969.

Indicates a congregation that relocated to St. Louis County from the city.
