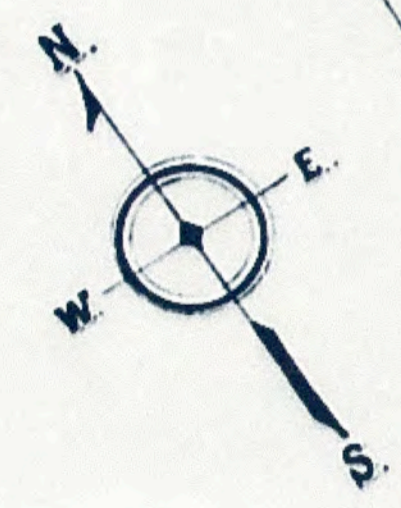


# Washington Park Cemetery
