
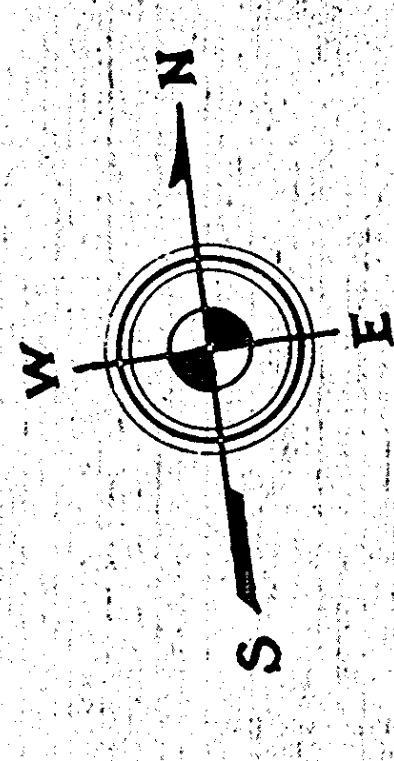

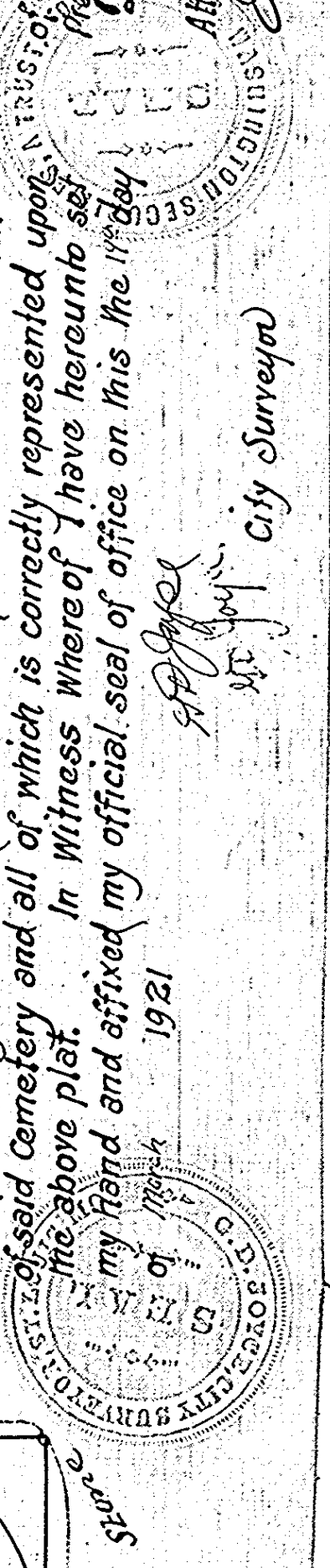

Joyce, City Surveyor of St. Louis, Mo., have during the month of March 1921, by order of the Washington Securities, a trust executed a survey of the above described tract of land in U.S. Section 49 T.45 N. R. 6 E. St. Louis Co. Mo. and have laid out the Cemetery and have also shown the location of the roads, ways, drives and walks shown on above described plan.
