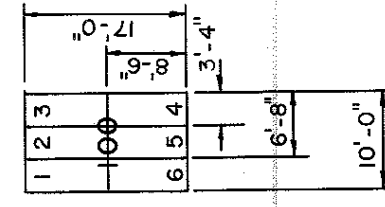

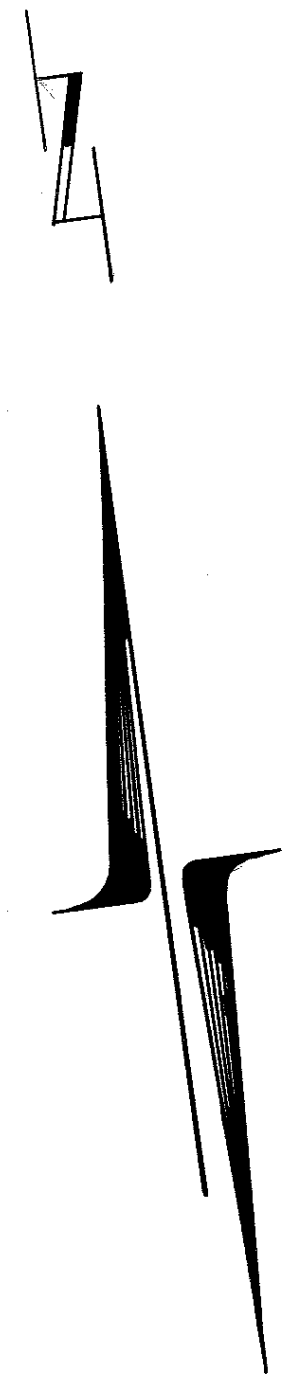
WASHINGTON PARK CEMETERY SECTION 10 - A

 T. 46 N., R. 6 E.

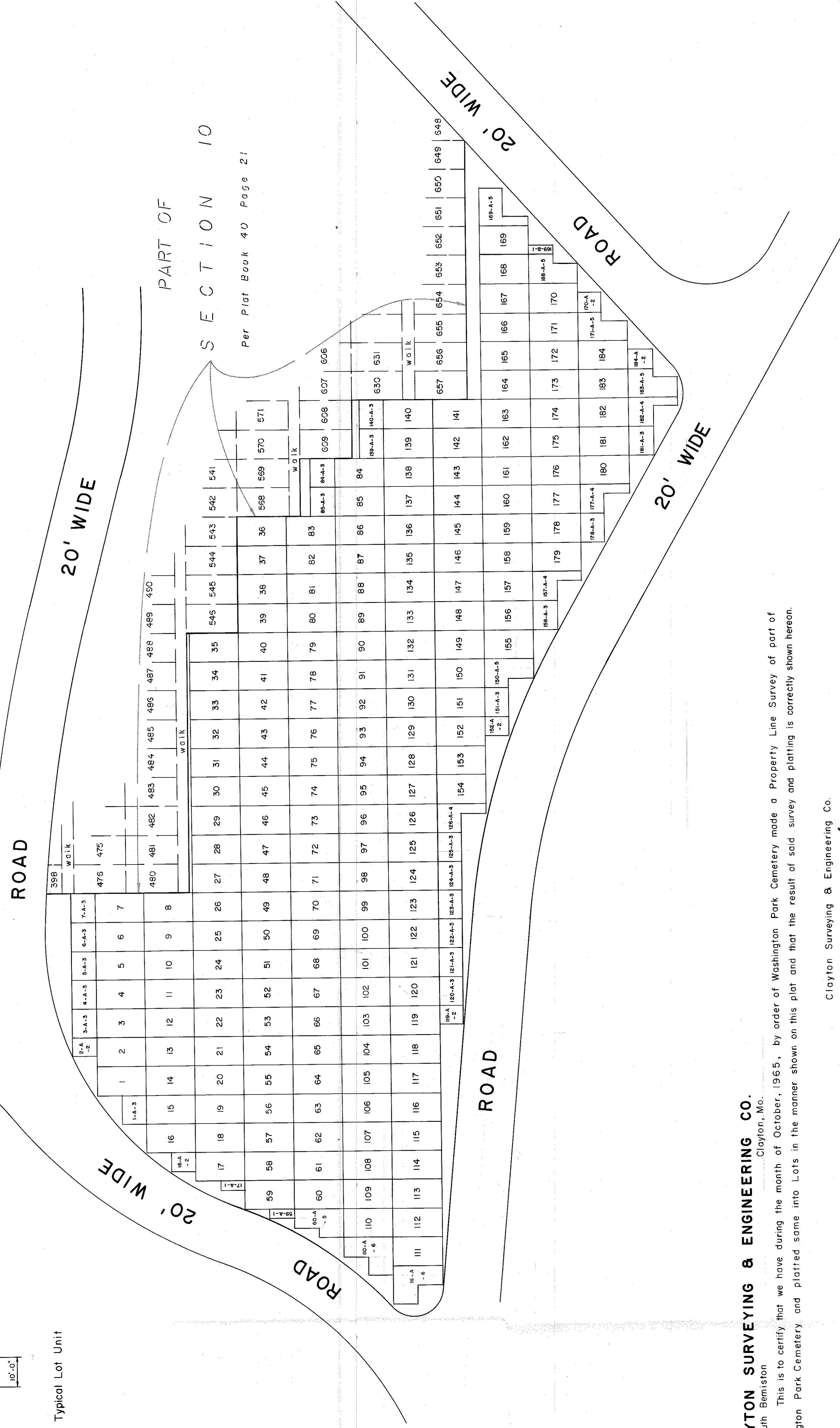

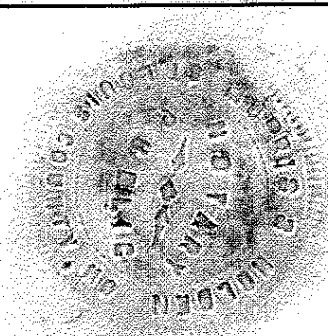
